COMMITTEE ACTION REPORT

Public Safety and Homeland Security

HB 124 - Georgia Public Safety Training Center; training of elected members; require

- **BILL SUMMARY:** This legislation makes the center and regional police academies available for certain public safety training. The training of elected members of county governing authorities, as to require newly elected members of a county governing authority to complete a comprehensive public safety training course to better prepare official for responding to a state of public emergency. The space should be reasonably available.

Georgia Public Safety Training Center and regional police academies shall make classroom space available free of charge for providing public safety instruction to local public officials.

The appropriations of funds by the General Assembly for grants or other funds are available to the Georgia Emergency Management Agency. Any newly elected members shall enroll in, attend, and satisfactorily complete a public safety course of training and instruction on pertaining local preparedness (ex: natural disaster, pandemic, epidemic, crisis response team development, crisis management planning, safe school planning, emergency operation planning, bomb threat management, model safety plans, etc). The facilities are Georgia Public Safety Training Center or regional police academies. The classes are conducted by the University of Georgia's Carl Vinson Institute of Government. The instruction shall be approved & developed by the Georgia Emergency Management Agency with assistance of the Georgia Bureau of Investigation and the Department of Public Safety. The Carl Vinson Institute of Government shall work with members of county governing authorities, Associations of County Commissioners of Investigation, and Georgia Department of Public Safety to establish, operate, and train in courses required by subsection in established rules and regulations. All reasonable expenses of training class required shall be paid through the Georgia Emergency Management Agency.

The course instruction should relate to chain of command and method of communication.
